Healthy Choices for Youth:



Mission: To help Students in grades 6-8 avoid risky, abusive behaviors associated with alcohol, tobacco, drugs and pre-marital sex; instead teach them to make healthy lifestyle choices (limited programs available for elementary & high school students).

- ◆ Total Students served: **2,488**
- ◆ School Districts served: **9**

Emergency Assistance:



Mission: To provide rental, utility, food, medication, infant necessities and fuel assistance (for employment transportation) to qualified families and individuals.

- ◆ Total dispersed: **\$15,375**
- ◆ Families receiving help: **379**

Youth Boosters:



Mission: To provide adult mentors for students (ages 8-12) in need of extra support and guidance.

- ◆ One-on-one weekly visits
- ◆ Monthly group activities
- ◆ Summer Camp (one week)
- ◆ Total Students served: **4**

A-Team:



Mission: To enable high school students the opportunity to serve as peer mentors to younger students. They promote abstinence from alcohol, tobacco, drugs and pre-marital sex. They use drama as a vehicle to teach these healthy lifestyle principles to 8th grade students.

- ◆ Total Presentations: **32**
